THREE COUNTIES GUIDE LINES FOR EXHIBITORS

This show will be run according to Covid-19 restrictions in place at the time of the event. Please do not bring anybody to the show who is displaying any Covid-19 symptom or who has been sheltering during the pandemic.

1. **WE ENCOURAGE COMPETITORS TO ENTER ON LINE:** www.threecounties.co.uk If you are unable to enter on line please email: equineteam@threecounties.co.uk for an entry form. All entries close **Monday 12 October**. No entries will be taken on the day.
2. Competitor numbers will not be sent out so please make your own competitor number wherever possible.
3. The classes will be limited in order to ensure that social distancing can take place. A revised timetable will be available on the Three Counties website should any times need to be amended. Classes will not be held before the published start time.
4. There will be adequate toilet facilities provided, which will be managed in line with government guidance in place at the time of the show. Hand sanitisers will be provided but competitors are also requested to bring hand sanitisers with them to the show and to keep hands sanitised / washed regularly.
5. Please park cars and horseboxes with adequate distance between them as indicated by the parking attendant.
6. First Aid cover will be available at the show. In the event of a fall of a horse or rider, the rider may only be attended by the designated first aid official.
7. There will be no Ride Judge in any class. All classes will be judged on display and conformation only.
8. There will be no stripping of horses for the Conformation phase. All exhibits will stand up for the Judge, walk away and trot towards the Judge before going straight into their individual display.
9. Grooms will be allowed into the Ring to put rugs on the horse / pony in the event of adverse weather.
10. A maximum of 3 people per horse are permitted which includes the rider. No spectators are permitted on the showground.
11. It is strongly recommended that all horses / ponies entering the Three Counties Showground are fully vaccinated against Equine Flu. Foals are exempt from vaccination but it is recommended that foals over the age of 6 months have received their first vaccination at least 7 days before the date of the show.

THREE COUNTIES SHOW RULES

1. **The Judge's decision is final.**
2. **ENTRY FEES:** All entry fees are inclusive of VAT @ 20% (any changes in the VAT rate will be applied from the due date).
3. **STABLING:** Limited Day stables are available. Exhibits must arrive and depart on the day of judging, unless stabling is booked and paid for. Exhibitors requiring stabling for their exhibits must reserve a stable (10' x 10') at a charge of £30 inclusive of VAT. Stables must be cleaned out by the exhibitor prior to departure.
4. **AGE:** It is only necessary to state the year of birth in respect of all horses.
5. **WEIGHT:** if in the opinion of the Judges an exhibit in the Ridden Hunter classes is in the wrong weight, transfer to the correct weight class is permitted, and no additional entry fee will be levied.
6. **CLASS ATTENDANCE:** it is the exhibitor's responsibility to present their exhibit(s) on time for classes.
7. **AMALGAMATION OF CLASSES:** The Society reserves the right to amalgamate classes if appropriate.
8. **FALL OF HORSE/PONY OR RIDER:** A fall of horse/pony or rider during any class will result in elimination. The rider must not remount in the ring and should see a medically qualified attendant before remounting.
9. **OWNERS/HANDLERS:** All horses must have a competent person in charge.
10. **DRESS CODE:** Grooms/Attendants appearing with animals in judging rings must be of smart appearance and in proper dress code (not jeans), with appropriate headwear,
11. **MOBILE PHONES:** The use of mobile phones is not permitted within the Collecting and judging Rings.
12. **TIMETABLE:** Classes may commence at or after the published time. The Society will not be responsible for any loss where an exhibitor has made entries in more than one class and because of a time over run it is not possible for him/her or the horse/pony to compete in one or more later classes. No claim for refund of fees paid or other loss, direct, indirect or consequential will be accepted or paid.

Once a class has commenced trotting it is deemed the class is closed and no further exhibitors may enter the ring.

13. **DOGS:** Must be kept on leads at all times and are only allowed in the car and lorry parks.
14. **REFUNDS:** No refunds will be issued for the withdrawal of entries.
15. **RESPONSIBILITY:** No responsibility will be accepted by the Organisers for any loss or damage however caused to property, or for any illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors and/or Riders or their Horses.
16. **MISCONDUCT:** Any exhibitor, groom, handler or rider who conducts themselves in an improper or offensive manner to any Judge, Member of Council, Steward or Official will be reported to the Chief Executive. He/she may be refused entry to the Showground and may not be allowed to compete in any class or competition that he/she may have entered for the Show.

- Class 9** **OPEN LWT COB**
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Rider any age.

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Rider any age.
- Class 11** **OPEN MAXI COB**
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over exceeding 155cms. Rider any age.

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 8th birthday. To be led by an attendant, the lead rein attached to the noseband only.

Class 17 OPEN SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday. Any suitable bridle.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 16-17 to compete.

Class 18 OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONY LEAD REIN

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday. To be led by an attendant, the lead rein attached to the noseband only.

Class 19 OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONY FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday. Any suitable bridle.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 18-19 to compete.

Class 20 OPEN 122CMS / 133CMS SHOW HUNTER PONY

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 133cms. Rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 21 OPEN 143CMS SHOW HUNTER PONY

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 22 OPEN 153CMS SHOW HUNTER PONY

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 20-22 to compete.

Class 23 RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD NATIVE / COB / TRADITIONAL HORSE

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider any age. To be shown in a natural state with full mane and tail or hogged and trimmed.

Class 24 RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD NATIVE / COB / TRADITIONAL PONY

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 148cms. Rider any age. To be shown in a natural state with full mane and tail or hogged and trimmed.

Class 25 RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD PLAITED HORSE
Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Rider any age. To be shown plaited and trimmed.

Class 26 RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD PLAITED PONY
Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cms. Rider any age. To be shown plaited and trimmed.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 23-26 to compete.

RoR Amateur definition:

Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

- a) An amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm.
- b) A person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind.
- c) An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season engaged in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.
- d) Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st 2020.
- e) Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season.
- f) Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season.
- g) A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show.

Class 27 ROR AMATEUR RIDDEN SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER SPONSORED BY TATTERSALLS
Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 years or over on the January 1st 2020. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavasson noseband. Horses should be plaited. The Series is open to AMATEURS only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under riding horse format without 'type' being taken into consideration. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. This class is a qualifier for the RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series FINAL. **The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the final. The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting 27th June 2021**
Rosettes 1st - 6th. Prizes - 1st £40 plus RoR jacket, 2nd £30, 3rd £20, 4th £10
RoR prizes will not be awarded to RoR qualifiers with numbers forward of two or less, however qualification for the final will stand.

Class 28 RIDDEN AMATEUR COBS / MAXI COBS
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms, to be shown hogged and trimmed. To be ridden by an amateur rider of any age.

Class 29 RIDDEN AMATEUR HACKS
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. To be ridden by an amateur rider of any age.

Class 30 RIDDEN AMATEUR PIEBALD / SKEWBALD
Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Any height or type. To be ridden by an amateur rider of any age.

Class 31 RIDDEN AMATEUR HUNTERS / SMALL HUNTERS
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. To be ridden by an amateur rider of any age.

Class 32 RIDDEN AMATEUR RIDING HORSES
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. To be ridden by an amateur rider of any age.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 28-32 to compete.
