THREE COUNTIES GUIDE LINES FOR EXHIBITORS

This show will be run according to Covid-19 restrictions in place at the time of the event. Please do not bring anybody to the show who is displaying any Covid-19 symptom or who has been sheltering during the pandemic.

1. **WE ENCOURAGE COMPETITORS TO ENTER ON LINE:** www.threecounties.co.uk If you are unable to enter on line please email: equineteam@threecounties.co.uk for an entry form. All entries close **Monday 12 October**. No entries will be taken on the day.
2. Competitor numbers will not be sent out so please make your own competitor number wherever possible.
3. The classes will be limited in order to ensure that social distancing can take place. A revised timetable will be available on the Three Counties website should any times need to be amended. Classes will not be held before the published start time.
4. There will be adequate toilet facilities provided, which will be managed in line with government guidance in place at the time of the show. Hand sanitisers will be provided but competitors are also requested to bring hand sanitisers with them to the show and to keep hands sanitised / washed regularly.
5. Please park cars and horseboxes with adequate distance between them as indicated by the parking attendant.
6. First Aid cover will be available at the show. In the event of a fall of a horse or rider, the rider may only be attended by the designated first aid official.
7. A maximum of 1 supporter per horse or for Junior riders a maximum of 2 supporters for the first pony and then one additional adult for any extra ponies are permitted. No spectators are permitted on the showground.

THREE COUNTIES SHOW RULES

1. **The Judge's decision is final.**
2. **ENTRY FEES:** All entry fees are inclusive of VAT @ 20% (any changes in the VAT rate will be applied from the due date).
3. **STABLING:** Limited Day stables are available. Exhibits must arrive and depart on the day of judging, unless stabling is booked and paid for. Exhibitors requiring stabling for their exhibits must reserve a stable (10' x 10') at a charge of £30 inclusive of VAT. Stables must be cleaned out by the exhibitor prior to departure.
4. **AGE:** It is only necessary to state the year of birth in respect of all horses.
5. **CLASS ATTENDANCE:** it is the exhibitor's responsibility to present their exhibit(s) on time for classes.
6. **FALL OF HORSE/PONY OR RIDER:** A fall of horse/pony or rider during any class will result in elimination. The rider must not remount in the ring and should see a medically qualified attendant before remounting.
7. **OWNERS/HANDLERS:** All horses must have a competent person in charge.
8. **MOBILE PHONES:** The use of mobile phones is not permitted within the Collecting and judging Rings.
9. **TIMETABLE:** Classes may commence at or after the published time. The Society will not be responsible for any loss where an exhibitor has made entries in more than one class and because of a time over run it is not possible for him/her or the horse/pony to compete in one or more later classes. No claim for refund of fees paid or other loss, direct, indirect or consequential will be accepted or paid.
10. **DOGS:** Must be kept on leads at all times and are only allowed in the car and lorry parks.
11. **REFUNDS:** No refunds will be issued for the withdrawal of entries.
12. **RESPONSIBILITY:** No responsibility will be accepted by the Organisers for any loss or damage however caused to property, or for any illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors and/or Riders or their Horses.
13. **MISCONDUCT:** Any exhibitor, groom, handler or rider who conducts themselves in an improper or offensive manner to any Judge, Member of Council, Steward or Official will be reported to the Chief Executive. He/she may be refused entry to the Showground and may not be allowed to compete in any class or competition that he/she may have entered for the Show.
14. **VACCINATIONS** - It is strongly recommended that all horses / ponies entering the Three Counties Showground are fully vaccinated against Equine Flu.

THREE COUNTIES UNAFFILIATED SHOW JUMPING SCHEDULE

SHOW JUMPING RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.
2. British Showjumping Dress Code is applicable in all classes. Correctly fitting hard hat manufactured to one of the minimum current standards (PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) with a kitemark, VG1 with a kitemark, ASTM F1163: 2004 onwards with a SEI mark, SNELL E2001 or E2016 with a SNELL label and number, AS/NZS 3838, from 2006 onwards) with a three-point linkage properly adjusted and fastened, must be worn at all times when mounted.
3. The show jumping classes will be run under BS Club Rules.
4. Classes will run as for Single Phase. Competitors must make themselves aware of the rules of the competition and the qualifiers.
5. The judge's and organiser's decision is final.
6. We strongly recommend that competitors wear body protectors for jumping.
7. Warm Up Areas: no-one on foot allowed in warm up areas. No lungeing / leading in SJ warm-up arena. No more than 5 horses in the SJ warm-up arena at any one time. Competitors must leave the warm-up areas if asked to do so by a steward/official.

Each team to consist of 3-4 riders per team, with the best three scores to count. All team members count as individual riders for each class. Class heights: 70cm, 80cm, 90cm, 1m. Please declare Team members & Team name at the Show Office at least 30 minutes before the class is due to commence.

PLEASE NOTE – ENTRIES WILL CLOSE BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE IF THE CLASS IS FULLY SUBSCRIBED. A WAITING LIST WILL BE HELD.

PLEASE COLLECT ROSETTES FROM THE SHOW OFFICE AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF THE CLASS.
